CLOSING THE EPHRATA LANDFILL
DURING EMERGENCY EVENTS

RESOLUTION No. 21- 006 -CC

WHEREAS, Grant County will close the Ephrata Landfill to the public during high wind events exceeding 25 mph, fires, chemical spills, or other hazardous situations as determined by Grant County; and

WHEREAS, Grant County will close the Ephrata Landfill to the public during the above-mentioned situations to protect the safety of the public and Grant County employees; and

WHEREAS, Grant County will provide notification of the emergency closures through social media and the Grant County Solid Waste website; and

WHEREAS, the Ephrata Landfill will remain open for commercial haulers during Emergency closures with normal hours of operation if it is safe to do so; and


WHEREAS, Grant County at its discretion may reject large commercial loads during high wind events that contain plastic, foil, and paper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT the Grant County Board of Commissioners, adopt, the closure of the Grant County Ephrata Landfill to the public during emergency events.


