Commingled Recyclables:

- **Plastic Bottles & Containers:** Plastics #1 PET & #2 HDPE (*bottles with opening smaller than base only*) **No lids!**
- **Aluminum & Tin Containers** (*rinsed, metal containers*)
- **Mixed Paper:** Newspaper and inserts, copier & printer paper, magazines, catalogs & phone books
- **Flattened Cardboard and/or Paperboard:** Corrugated cardboard, shoe boxes, cereal boxes, and cracker boxes (*No frozen food boxes*)

Does not accept: Plastic bags and film, glass, glass bottles & containers, frozen food boxes, shredded paper, paper food & beverage cartons, scrap metal, batteries, tub containers, lids and caps, plastic clam shell containers, foil, chip bags, aerosol cans, and foam cups & containers

Rinse out all cans and bottles!

No plastic bags!

No plastic lids and caps!

Accepts in separate containers:

- Flattened corrugated cardboard (no paperboard)
- Glass bottles and jars—all colors (no lids)
- Aluminum cans (buy back)
