YOUTH SERVICES DETENTION ELECTRONIC CONTROLS REPLACEMENT**

Request For Proposals/Bids

Grant County is seeking proposals/bids for the replacement and expansion of electronic controls for its Youth Services detention facility, located in Ephrata, Washington, with a primary emphasis on the upgrade and integration of the various systems (door controls, intercom systems, cameras, etc.), including a number of specified requirements included within a Request for Proposals/Bid Packet (RFP Packet).

Vendors are encouraged to team up with other vendors if doing so would result in a proposal that will produce the best solution for the County's need.

It is anticipated the County will enter into a contractual agreement with the company/companies or firm(s) to be selected as part of this RFP. Contract and project expectations are set forth in the RFP Packet, which may be obtained beginning Monday, October 14th at:

The deadline for proposals/bids is 4:30 p.m. on Wednesday, October 30, 2013. An original proposal/bid and three (3) photocopies must be submitted as shown below in a sealed envelope clearly marked with project title: "Grant County Youth Services Detention Electronic Controls Replacement". Late proposals and/or proposals submitted *via* e-mail or facsimile will not be accepted.

Proposals will be opened on Wednesday, October 30, at 4:35 p.m. in the Commissioners' lobby located on the 2nd floor of the Grant County Courthouse at 35 C Street NW in Ephrata, Washington.
